#### **U3 Co-ed (born 2007)**

***A Parent/ Tot participation program.*** Eight week session (Week of June 21 to Aug.13). The focus is on keeping children active while learning basic soccer elements. Volunteer coaches will guide the parents and players through fun drills and games. The program design is flexible and builds on input from players and parents to ensure everyone has fun while learning about soccer. Each player is required to have shin pads, socks to cover the shin pads and proper soccer cleats or sneakers.

#### **U4 Co-ed (born 2006)**

***A Parent/ Tot participation program.*** Eight week session (Week of June 21 to Aug.13). The focus is on keeping children active while learning basic soccer elements. Volunteer coaches will guide the parents and players through fun drills and games. The program design is flexible and builds on input from players and parents to ensure everyone has fun while learning about soccer. Each player is required to have shin pads, socks to cover the shin pads and proper soccer cleats or sneakers.

#### **U5 / U6 Co-ed (born 2005, 2004)**

A once a week program or twice a week program. Skill development includes basic agility, dribbling and spatial concepts. Volunteer coaches will guide the players through fun drills and games. Each player is required to have shin pads, socks to cover the shin pads and proper soccer cleats or sneakers.

#### **U8 Co-ed (born 2003, 2002)**

The U8's will have two, one-hour sessions per week, at Gaetz Brook Jr. High field. One evening will be a practice night, the other game night. There will be makeup games for rainouts. Skill development includes basic agility and ball control and other introductory skills. Each player is required to have shin pads, socks to cover the shin pads and proper soccer cleats or sneakers.

#### **U10 Girls & Boys (born 2001, 2000)**

The U10's will have two, one-hour sessions per week, at Gaetz Brook Jr. High field. One evening will be a practice night, the other game night. There will be makeup games for rainouts. Skill development includes basic agility and ball control and other introductory skills to prepare for competitive play in the U12 CISL division. Each player is required to have shin pads, socks to cover the shin pads and proper soccer cleats or sneakers.

## **Youth Soccer Program Descriptions: 2010**

### **All Fees Must Be Paid Prior to Start of Season**

#### **Super 8 : 8 Aside Program**

Teams play in the Capital Inter District Soccer League (CISL) with approximately one to two games per week beginning June 1st and running through mid August. There will be approximately 16 games during the season. These games are held on artificial turf and are considered **playable in all weather. Games will go ahead in the rain and will only be cancelled during storms.** Cancellation will be determined only by the CISL. Practice sessions will be held at least once per week. Indoor practices will be held in April and May.

7 a-side games on a smaller field, the players are able to move from position to position, from defense to offence making the game more exciting for them. The smaller field and smaller number of players on the field help the player develop his/her technique as they have more time on the ball. With more touches on the ball, the player will develop his/her soccer skills and have more opportunity to be actively involved in the game. With fewer players on the field, there is extra space which gives the player more time to make decisions. This helps develop the tactical side of the game.

In 7 a-side games rules such as throw ins, free kicks, corner kicks and goal kicks still apply.

## Youth Soccer Program Descriptions: 2010

### All Fees Must Be Paid Prior to Start of Season

#### Tier 2B

Tier 2B is a competitive and committed level of soccer in Nova Scotia. Teams play in the Capital Inter District Soccer League (CISL) with approximately two games per week beginning late May and running through mid August. League games are usually scheduled on weekdays with the exception of rain out games, which are held on Saturday and Sundays as outlined and scheduled by the CISL. There will be one to two scheduled practice per week. Teams may also participate in one to two tournaments during the summer season. **Players at this level are expected to be committed to soccer.** Indoor practices will be held in April and May. Home games are played at O'Connell School Field. If there are not enough players at a level, to form a both a boys and girls team; players will be brought together to play under one team and will be entered under the boys division.
